王其钧，Born in Xuzhou, Jiangsu Province, in 1954, Wang Qijun began his professional studies at the Department of Fine Arts, Nanjing Art College, later obtained his master's degree from the Department of Architecture, Chongqing College of Architectural Engineering. He used to be an editor with the China Architecture & Building Press, but has, since graduating from Nanjing Art College, also been a painter, many of his works for which he has been awarded a number of prizes been shown at exhibitions both on a national and provincial level. A number of his paintings have appeared in Fine Arts and other journals. His monograph, Chinese Vernacular Dwellings, examines the type, layout, structure, workmanship and aesthetics of these buildings. Drawings in traditional style accompany the text. The author has later on written another book on the subject, Chinese Traditional Domestic Architecture, and recently had a number of papers published in the following journals: Architects, Architectural Journal, Fine Arts and Studies on Fine Arts, among others.

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
