内容概要

《社会科学论文中的人际意义研究:体裁视角分析》从跨学科的角度研究社会科学论文体裁中的人际意义,以功能语言学对人际意义的研究为基本框架,融合体裁分析、语用学、修辞学、批评话语分析、巴赫金对话理论和社会建构理论,建立了一个社会科学论文人际意义的分析模式。

Beyond functional grammar, voices from other fields call our attention to the significance of studying interpersonal meaning, though this significance is perceived and emphasized from different perspectives in different theories. Therefore, in the subsequent section, study of IP from the perspective of rhetoric, pragmatics, philosophy, discourse analysis, and literary criticism is presented. It should be noted here that the foregoing discussion ofinterpersonal meaning in various areas can not be divided as explicitly as it looks in the next section. Overlapping seems in evitable. The division into several parts is only for the sake of convenience in discussion.
