Section B **Directions :** In this section , you will hear 2 short passages. At the end of the each passage , you will hear some questions. Both the passage and the questions will be spoken only once. After you hear a question , you must choose the best answer from the four choices marked A) , B) , C) and D) . Then mark the corresponding letter on the Answer Sheet with a single line through the centre.

Passage One A farmer went into the forest to cut some wood for his fire. He climbed up onto a big tree and began cutting the branches-it was the branch he was sitting on. One of his neighbors happened to be passing and saw the farmer sitting in the tree , busily cutting the branch at a place between himself and the trunk of the tree. The neighbor said to the farmer : “ You ’ d better be careful. If you go on like that , you ’ ll have a nasty accident. When that branch breaks and comes down , you ’ re going to fall down with it. ” The farmer was angry. “ I don ’ t need your advice. ” he said , “ Mind your own business ! ” The neighbor realized that it was no good arguing and went on his way. A few minutes later the farmer finished cutting the branch. It fell to the ground with a crash , and so did he. “ That neighbor of mine is not as stupid as I thought , ” he said to himself , “ In fact he ’ s a very clever man-he can tell the future ! ” And the next time they met in the village , the farmer asked him. “ Could you tell me how many children I am going to have ? ”

Questions 14 to 16 are based on the passage you have just heard. 14. Which branch did he cut ? (C) 15. Was the farmer grateful for the neighbor ’ s advice ? (D) 16. What happened to the farmer when the branch fell ? (B)

Passage Two Charles Lindbergh was the first man to fly the Atlantic alone. He had been a pilot , flying back and forth between Chicago and the city of St. Louis. Determined to win the \$25 , 000 prize for the first flight from New York to Paris , Lindbergh persuaded a group of St. Louis businessmen to finance the building of a special plane for him. The news that Lindbergh was to fly the Atlantic alone was received with disbelief. The plane would not fly , people said. It had only a single engine. Men called him the “ flying fool ” . But on May 20 , 1927 , Lindbergh ’ s plane struggled into the air from a New York airport. At one time he was flying only a few feet above the ocean. But after 34 hours of continuous flying , Lindbergh finally landed at an airport near Paris. Questions 17 to 20 are based on the passage you have just heard. 17. How much was offered for the first flight from New York to Paris ? (D) 18. What did the public think of his flight ? (A) 19. When did his plane start flying ? (B) 20. How long did it take Lindbergh to fly from New York to Paris ? (A)

Section C **Directions :** In this section , you will hear a passage three times. When the passage is read for the first time , you should listen carefully for its general idea. When the passage is read for the second time , you are required to fill in the blanks numbered from 21 to 26 with the exact words you have just heard. For blanks numbered from 27 to 30 you are required to fill in the missing information. For these blanks , you can either use the exact words you have just heard or write down the main points in your own words. Finally , when the passage is read for the third time , you should check what you have written.

The United States covers a large part of the North American continent. Its (21) neighbors are Canada to the north , and Mexico to the south. (22) Although the United States is a big (23) country , it is not the largest in the world. In 1964 , its (24) population was over 185 (25) million. When this land first became a nation , after winning (26) independence from England , it had thirteen states. (27) Each of these states was represented on the American flag by a star. All these states (28) were in the eastern part of the continent. As the nation grew toward the west , new states were added and (29) new stars appeared on the flag. For a long time , there were 48 stars. In 1959 , however , (30) two more stars were added to the flag , representing the new states of Alaska and Hawaii.
