CRITICS often regard The Plumed Serpent (1926) as theheight of Lawrence's interest in authoritarian politics. IHowever, if this novel represents the most notorious instance of Lawrence's proto-fascist leanings, it also ushers in a much-noted moment of vacillation in his political thought. Within a year after its publication, Lawrencewrote letters that appear to repudiate his leadership vision. One written to Trigant Burrow on 13 July 1927 refers to the "hero illusion", while another to Witter Bynner dated 13 March 1928 flatly asserts that "The hero is obsolete, and the leader of men is a back number. After all, at the backof the hero is the militant ideal: and the militant ideal, orthe ideal militant, seems to me also a cold egg. I agree withyou, the leader-cum-follower relationship is a bore, , .2It is the contention of tlus essay that these letters do notinaugurate a new stage in Lawrence's thought but rather continue an earlier one.
