PREFACE China is a large country boasting highly varied climatic and geographical features. Grand vegetative habitats supporting a great diversity of mammalian life. Five hundred thirty-four species of mammals under 14 orders and 56 families are found in China, comprising about 12.5% of total living mammalian fauna on earth. China thus ranks among the most mammalian-diverse countries in the world. Wild mammals are a vital component of the natural ecosystem and as such are indispensable to the well-being of mankind. Since the beginning of human history, man has exploited mammals for his own purposes, i.e. providing him with food, clothing, and medicine, as well as sport and recreation and even an outlet for human artistic expression. Today, mammals are exploited for the same purposes as in the past and will continue to be vitally important to man far into the future. In spite of their importance to man, however, more and more mammalian species in the world are in decline and/or in danger of extinction, often due to man-made problems. In China as everywhere, habitat destruction caused by human activity and population pressures, environmental pollution, pesticides, and climatic change, etc. have caused severe depletion in numbers of many species, threatening the very survival of many of China's indigenous mammals. In the 1980s, the dwindling numbers of animals, especially among the medium-sized and large-sized mammals, set off an alarm in both the Chinese and international scientific communities. In an effort to check the rapid decline in wildlife within its borders, the Chinese Government enacted the Wildlife Protection Law of the People's Republic of China on November 8, 1988. In accordance with this Wildlife Protection Law, on December 10, 1988, the State Department issued a Key List of Protected Animals of all those wildlife species requiring governmental protection. Both the Wildlife Protection Law and the Key List of Protected Animals have served as linchpins of official Chinese policy on domestic wildlife conservation issues ever since. The purpose of Mammals of China is multifold. It first aims to supply the general public with information presented in a colorful, entertaining and understandable way, while focusing on the ultimate goals of promoting public awareness of the existence and importance of China's rich and diverse wild mammalian resources; promoting public awareness of the plight of many of these species and
